
HOW TO LIGHT

Kindle one light (the one on the far right) on the first night of Chanukah, two lights on the second night (the two furthest on the right), and so on-until the eighth night, when eight lights are kindled. Use an additional light, the shamash ("servant candle") to kindle the lights.

Recite the blessings, and then kindle the lights. Begin with the newest light, the one farthest to the left, and then proceed from left to right.

(On Friday the Menorah is lit before the Shabbat candles; On Saturday it is lit once Shabbat ends.)

After kindling the menorah, it is customary to sing "Hanerot Halalu" or "Maoz Tzur".
